Organised choir session	Exposure to COVID-19 and subsequent infection	All members (including choir leader) attending sessions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- All existing choir members and potential new members, will be required to book and pay for their place in advance online (bank details below), to avoid payment by cash or cheque on the door.  <b>J McGowan Hayes</b> <b>11-01-09</b> <b>00330087</b></li><li>- Everyone is advised to complete a lateral flow test before attending a choir session.</li><li>- Everyone is required to sanitise their hands on arrival and on departure. Hand sanitiser will be available at the door, although individuals may wish to bring their own.</li><li>- Masks are to be worn when entering and exiting the room.</li><li>- Masks will not be required for singing but may of course be worn if desired.</li></ul>

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Physical distancing will be necessary when singing and coloured markers will indicate positions for standing.</li><li>- Windows and doors will be kept open to help ventilation and limit contact with handles.</li><li>- Members are advised to bring their own water bottle as there will be no other water available.</li><li>- The bar will not be open after the session.</li><li>- Word sheets will not be handed out but can instead be downloaded from the choir website if required.</li><li>- Members should not attend if they feel unwell, have any suspected symptoms of COVID-19 or have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.</li><li>- If any member develops COVID-19 symptoms after a choir session, they must contact the organiser, <b>Jackie McGowan Hayes (07526 922895)</b>, who will pass the information on to the choir.</li></ul>
